WHY APPLY?

Chevening offers a unique opportunity for outstanding future leaders from over 160 countries and territories to pursue one-year master's degrees in any subject at any UK university.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

In order to submit an eligible Chevening Scholarship application, you must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country, and return there for a minimum of two years after completing your scholarship
- Have completed an undergraduate degree
- Have at least two years' work experience
- Not have previously received funding from the UK government to study in the UK

There is no upper age limit.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Read this leaflet carefully. Keep it for future reference
- Identify three different eligible UK master's courses, and apply to each of them
- Book your English language test
- Secure two references for your application
- Apply online between 8 August and 8 November at www.chevening.org/apply

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

early 2017 All candidates are informed of the status of their applications. The strongest candidates are interviewed.

mid 2017 Interviewed candidates are notified of whether they have been conditionally selected, are on a reserve list, or are not being progressed.

July 2017 Selected and reserve candidates must have received an unconditional offer for at least one of their three course choices and must have met Chevening's English language requirement to remain eligible

Sept - Oct 2017 Successful applicants commence their studies in the UK as Chevening Scholars.
