1. Program Overview

2. Schedule of the 2022 Programs

In 2022, KORASS will provide Master’s Degree Program in Korean Government Scholarship Program for Oversea Government Railway Staffs in collaboration with Seoul National University of Science and Technology. Please find the attached file for the detailed information of the application schedule of the programs which will be started in the second half of 2022.

3. Recommendation of Applicants

KORASS receives the recommendations of applicants from the government of its partner countries. Each country can recommend many applicants without limitations of applicant's number. SEOULTECH selects applicants based on the recommendation and the result of selection procedure.

Because KORASS receives the recommendation from the government, the applicant should submit official letter of the government which approves the nomination of the applicant.

4. Application Eligibility

Applicants should

- Be a citizen of the Fellowship Program target country
- Be officially nominated by their government
- Be a government official or an employee in the public sector.
- Be a university/college graduate or have an equivalent educational background.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally.
- Have not previously received a scholarship from the Korean government.
- A participant who has once withdrawn from the program due to a failure to attain certain grades, a violation of the rules of the training institute, or a false entry is not allowed to re-apply for Fellowship Program.

5. Selection Procedure

1) Selection Procedure

The Selection procedure will include two rounds: An evaluation of the application package by the university in Round 1, and a video or telephone interview by the University in Round 2. All the procedure will be conducted by university directly.

2) 1st round : an evaluation of the application package

The University will conduct the evaluation of application package. Based on the result of the evaluation of application package by the University, the University will select applicants for the 2nd round.

3) 2nd round

Interviews will be conducted only for those who have passed the first round, and the university will contact the person individually to set an appointment for the interview.

The interview will be conducted in the place where internet environment is smooth so that video interview is available.

6. Notification of Final Nominees

When final nominee is selected, the Korean embassy will notify that individual (The University will also contact the nominees directly.), and the information related to the departure will be distributed to the participants from university. Postponement of the enrollment is not allowed, in principle.

Program participants are requested to prepare and submit their country report individually or as a group (each country) to the Global Railway Expert Training Course Manager at Seoul Tech via e-mail at globalrail@seoultech.ac.kr until **August 31, 2022**.

Note. Korean Government Scholarship Program includes a 'Country report' session where participants have an opportunity to analyze each country's current status and circumstances in the program subject and share it with other participants and Korean experts. It aims to provide appropriate solutions and insights to the identified problems and issues of their countries.

The country report should be in MS PowerPoint format. The length of the report should not exceed twenty A4-sized pages. The report should be written in English and double-spaced.

All participants are required to give a 15-minute presentation on their country report individually or as a group.

2. TOPICS TO BE COVERED IN THE COUNTRY REPORT

All participants will make an individual or group presentation titled "Country report" following the guidelines below:

A. Programs to provide education of highly professional experts who can lead the industry and research in advanced railway technology

- **Possible subject 1:** Status of railway industry and facing issues.
- **Possible subject 2:** Advanced railway technology status and status of professional education also technology development.
- **Possible subject 3:** Industry forecast of railway and relationship with Korean railway Industry

B. Details of Country Report Preparation

- **National level service structure**
 - Introduce your organization including personnel, main roles, and policy.
 - Introduce your railway industry including scale of plant equipment, advanced railway technology, professional training in railway field.
- **Strategic policies**
 - Describe government policies or guidelines on the above subjects. (Short-term or long-term plans: goals, priorities, strategies, etc.)
- **Data collection, reporting and monitoring system**
 - What kinds of statistical data are collected?
 - Describe major problems with the current data collection, reporting and monitoring system.

- Is there any quality control and quality assurance activities?

• **Statistical data on the following information (Please indicate the source of the data)**

- Railway safety management
- International rail interchange status
- Chart production

• **Other relevant information**

- Railway related laws
- Is there any specialized education for railway?

3. Policy on Misconduct
